Ambassador Nakano and Mrs. Nakano hosted a Farewell Reception in honour of the 2017 selected Japan Exchange and Teaching (JET) Participants at their official residence on Friday, July 7, 2017. A total of twenty eight Jamaicans were selected to serve as Assistant Language Teachers (ALTs) in Japan for the 2017-2018 academic year. Ten of the participants left the island in April of this year and the remaining eighteen are scheduled to depart on July 22, 2017.

All Speakers delivered encouraging messages and solid words of advice to the departing ALTs. They were Mr. Dean-Roy Bernard, Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Education, Youth and Information and Mrs. Florence Blackwood, Senior Director, Sports Development and Monitoring, Ministry of Culture, Gender, Entertainment and Sports President of the Japan Exchange and Teaching Alumni Association (JJETAA), Ms. Sheena Jarrett.

After this new batch of JETs departs for Japan, a total of 343 will have been to Japan on the Programme since its inception.


