	[Background and current situation] The Jamaican economy, which saw negative growth due to the global economic crisis in 2008, grew again in 2012 as a result of the recovering global economy. Although it recorded a slight growth in 2011, it is rising up again due to the results of structural reforms effort by the Government and the impact of a decline in crude oil prices. However, the unemployment rate (13.2%, PIOJ, 2016) is still at a high level, and expansion of employment opportunities continues to be an important position in government measures. Meanwhile, the Jamaican government has a large debt portfolio (115% of GDP, Ministry of Finance and the Public Service, 2017), and so it is strongly required to control fiscal expenditure. If not controlled, it is difficult for the Government to implement public works such as infrastructure with its own financial resources.
