

Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Project Signing Ceremony for The Project for Rehabilitation of the Community Center in St. Andrew Southern Region

On March 11, 2022, the grant contract (84,120 USD) was signed between Ambassador Fujiwara and Mr. Cunningham representing St. Luke's Anglican Church.

In his remarks, Ambassador Fujiwara highly evaluated the social contribution activities that St. Luke's Anglican Church has been carrying out for the communities of St. Andrew Southern region. These activities include the provision of breakfast on Wednesday and lunch on Friday, implementation of workshops, and free medical check-ups. Moreover, he pointed out that preventing adverse health effects and providing a safe environment in which people can receive social service activities by removing asbestos correspond with the principle of human security, and is extremely important.

By rehabilitating the asbestos roof of the community center, this project assists in preventing adverse health effects and also enabling resumption of the food and medical assistance as well as youth and childcare education programs in a safe environment while empowering local residents.

Organizations who are involved in the social contribution activities and stakeholders attended the event and emphasized the importance of securing a safe environment. In addition, they expressed the expectation for resumption of the social assistance.
